SCHEDULE A-2 FARM, CIVIC, AND ANCILLARY RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

Available in all territory served by the Cooperative, subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Cooperative on file with the Virginia State Corporation Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to non-residential farms, single phase accounts that are ancillary to a residential account (e.g., wells, pumps, barns, shops, etc.), volunteer fire departments, volunteer rescue squads, civic clubs, and similar non-profit community service organizations, along the lines of the Cooperative for all uses. The maximum demand to be provided under Schedule A-2 shall be 50 kW.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single phase, 60 cycle, at available secondary voltages; and multi-phase, where available, at secondary voltage subject to special contract at the discretion of the Cooperative. Motor installations shall meet the requirements of Section IV, Part H Electric Service Limitations of the Cooperative's Terms and Conditions for Providing Electric Service."
