SCHEDULE PL PRIVATE AREA LIGHTING [CLOSED]

AVAILABILITY

Available in all territory served by the Cooperative, subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Cooperative on file with the Virginia State Corporation Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable for lighting of the private property of customers presently taking metered Distribution Delivery Service under one of the Cooperative's available Schedules. Schedule PL will be closed to new lighting or replacement lighting as of October 1, 2018.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Service shall be rendered by use of a mercury vapor, or high pressure sodium, outdoor lights based on the manufacturer's nominal lamp rating.

CONTRACT TERM AND BILLING

Standard contracts shall be for term of two (2) years and thereafter from year to year and terminated by notice of at least sixty (60) days from either party. Bills will be rendered monthly in accordance with the charges shown in the rate table.

MONTHLY RATE TABLE

The Energy Supply Service Charge shall be applied to the listed "Estimated Average Monthly kWh" usage for the particular light type, as stated below, to determine the monthly rate.

TYPE OF FIXTURE

The type of fixture and method of installation shall be in accordance with the Cooperative standards.

Service under Schedule PL will continue to be supplied at those locations being serviced at the rates set forth. Effective October 1, 2018 current HPS/MV fixtures will be maintained as long as repair parts are available or until an equivalent LED fixture is offered by the Cooperative. In the event such an existing fixture is discontinued at the Customer's request, it shall no longer be available at that location. No additional such fixtures will be supplied. At the Customer's option, the Cooperative will, at the Cooperative's cost and after reasonable notification to the Customer, either (a) remove and not replace the defective fixture or (b) replace the same with the Cooperative's nearest equivalent LED fixture.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

When an additional wood pole is required for security or street lights and is furnished or installed by the Cooperative, the charge will be \$1.53 per pole per month for all installations. A five year contract will be required for the light service and pole. The Customer may furnish and install a pole that meets the requirements of the Cooperative in lieu of the Cooperative furnished and installed wood pole in which case no pole charge will be made and the term of the contract will be the normal two year term.

Effective: On bills issued on and after October 1, 2018

DESCRIPTION OF EQUIPMENT TO BE SUPPLIED

Cooperative will install, own, and maintain a standard type luminaire and bracket mounted on a Cooperative pole or an approved pole owned by the Customer.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. Private lighting service is available to individual Customers provided Cooperative has in place existing secondary service facilities.
2. When additional circuits or poles are required on the Customer's premises, such additional circuits and poles shall be paid for, owned, and maintained by Cooperative.
3. Any additional circuits or equipment necessary on Cooperative poles shall be installed by Cooperative at Customer's expense but will be owned and maintained by Cooperative.
4. When a lighting unit is attached to a Cooperative pole and is located along a public right of way, the lighting unit furnished under this Schedule must then extend over the Customer's private property and not over the public right-of-way. The decision as to the location of a private lighting unit on Cooperative poles rests solely with the Cooperative and the installation of equipment must conform with the regulations of public authorities having jurisdiction in the area.
5. The Cooperative will maintain and service only Cooperative owned equipment.
6. Lamps shall be lighted from dusk to dawn each night, approximately 4,100 hours per year.
7. New installations shall remain in service for a minimum of one year. The Cooperative may require payment for removals or relocations of new installations in service for less than one (1) year.
8. Cooperative will provide re-lamp when necessary and maintain the fixture and glassware which it owns. All other maintenance will be at Customer's expense.
9. Lamp renewals and/or maintenance will be performed during normal working hours within a reasonable period following notification by the Customer to the Cooperative.
10. All installations must be accessible to Cooperative maintenance trucks and personnel for re-lamping and repairs. The 4 ft. and 8 ft. brackets under Group B are limited to 30 ft. mounting height and available only in locations accessible by bucket type service truck.
11. Cooperative reserves the right to discontinue service where cost of service is excessive because of vandalism or other reasons.
12. The Cooperative will only attach lighting units to utility owned poles or approved private poles.

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT RIDER

The amount of charges calculated under the above rates for Electricity Supply Service are subject to increase or decrease under provisions of the Cooperative's Power Cost Adjustment Rider, Schedule PCA-1.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Cooperative's Terms and Conditions for Providing Electric Service, as filed with the Virginia State Corporation Commission, shall apply to service under this rate schedule.
